**An excursion to the Sports Hall of Fame** includes a structured program which allows students and children to learn about their local history, view artifacts and photographs from the past and develop a sense of community pride.

In addition to our on-site education programs, we are also pleased to have available for educators a variety of **Sports Heritage Education Resource Materials**.
